Hall Degan writing handbell music in 1991 because at that time, there were very few published handbell compositions for Catholic handbell choin. His first handbell trile was published in 1995 and has published serveral titles since. Many of his titles have been found on "best selfer inis" by publishers/distributors and recorded by nationally acclaimed handbell choin: M. Hall has served as a clinician for AGEHB local, regional and national seminars. He remains active composing commission works for fortivula and individual choirs such as The Faleigh Eingers.
